Encamping, Listening to Instructions

Exodus 19-40, Numbers 1-4

1. Encamp and Learn

God teaches and reminds the Israelites to listen to His instructions through the process of camping. Ever since their exodus from Egypt, during every camp that was set up, God allowed them to learn about truth and about abandoning their old self. When they reached the foot of Mount Sinai, they camped there for a very long time and only in Numbers Chapter 10 that they moved again.

When God's footsteps stop, we need to encamp. The time of we are encamped and settled is the time when God teaches, and the time when we learn, it is to prepare us for the journey when we move forward again. It was during such a time that Moses went up the mountain and received the Ten Commandments. Learn to prepare God's sanctuary, tabernacle, all the tools as well as prepare the people who would serve Him and the Chief Priest. The Israelites were transformed from slaves who were not limited by any law to a group of people who received the highest form of law; From a rebellious group of people who had no ears for listening to a big army who could obey. All these are the result of their learning during the time of encampment.

2. Preparing the Formation for Moving Camp

From Numbers Chapter 1 onwards, God used 20 days to rearrange the Israeli army of 2 million people, plus to teach them how to move camp. God clearly taught them how to arrange their formation and how to move and as such had to clearly listen to and receive instructions from the right people. They would encamp around the tent of meeting; On the east would be Judah as the leader, along with Issachar and Zebulun; On the west, Ephraim as leader, along with Benjamin and Manasseh; On the south, Reuben as leader, along with Simeon and Gath; and on the north, Dan as leader, along with Asher and Naphtali. In the center of the tent and the people were the Levites, along with the family of Aaron and Moses. The Israelites moved forward according to the tent's direction and formation and could not change any of their positions. Leaders were supposed to lead and the Israelites had to have total submission in order to reach their goal of reaching the Promised Land.

3. Moving Camp, A Test of Abilities

When moving camp and moving forward, that is the time to see whether the people had listened to instructions carefully when they were encamped. Moving camp and moving forward requires focus on moving forward and there is simply no time to stop and to learn slowly. From Numbers chapters 13 to 20, it was evident that the Israelites only had the formation for moving camp, but they did not have the lifestyle nor character because they were constantly complaining, to the extent of resulting their own deaths in the wilderness, and their children also had to wander in the wilderness (Num. 14: 33). Only after Aaron died, then they were able to move forward. But in Kadesh, God's leading stopped and the Israelites had to encamp there for almost 38 years. God used the Book of Numbers to once again teach them to obey His ordinances.

Encamping is for one specific instance; training is for an opportunity. A person's character is the result of everyday "training". This is why we should always learn to submit, learn to carefully listen and receive God's instructions. When faced with a difficult decision, that is the time of testing for our character. Encampment, is our daily life, cellgroup, worship and pray, waiting upon God, attending courses and getting equipped. Moving camp, is the time when we face a great choice, whether or not we will be able to make the right choice and to move forward depends on whether or not we have learnt our lessons during the time of encampment; This will be time to test our abilities. Only after we have really learnt, then God will allow us to move camp and move forward. ■ 【This sermon message was delivered on August 11, 2013. Edited by Sec. of editors】

The Malaysian National Evangelical Christian Fellowship (NECF) 40-day Prayer Fasting, 7/8/- 15/9. Brothers and sisters may purchase the prayer guide May Your Kingdom Come for RM2 from the church service counter.

For my house shall be called a house of prayer for all peoples.
(Isaiah 56: 7b)

Prayer is the key to transforming an individual, the church and the nation. Let us build a prayer altar together by simply increasing the quality and quantity of our prayers.

Hundred Altars: 2 -3 persons praying together for 5 mins formed an altar.

Thousand Men: The total number of persons who forms the altars.
Ten Thousand Hours: Accumulated praying hours spent in a month.

Methods:

1. Personal altar - 15 mins of praying everyday, For e.g.: Morning, noon and night respectively. Pray for your relationship with God for 5 mins. (Recommend to use the NECF 40 days Prayer Fasting Handbook.)
2. Family/Company/School altars - Set up altars with 1 or 2 more persons at home, company or school. Can refer to the weekly bulletin prayer focus for prayer items.
3. Cell Group Altar: For the months of August and September, weekly cell groups are to be conducted in the manner of altar building. (please refer to the weekly cell materials)

3 Steps of Altar Building: (suitable for any altars)

1. Worship : Begin with one or two praise and worship songs
2. Scriptures: Pray for God to lead by reading the altar building scriptures for that week
3. Prayer : Using the altar building scriptures to pray for all matters.

Prayer Focus

Materials for this week's altar building:

1. Worship:

Start with worshipping and praising God with one or two songs

2. Verses:

On the day the tabernacle, the tent of the covenant law, was set up, the cloud covered it. From evening till morning the cloud above the tabernacle looked like fire. That is how it continued to be; the cloud covered it, and at night it looked like fire.

Whenever the cloud lifted from above the tent, the Israelites set out; wherever the cloud settled, the Israelites encamped.

(Numbers 9:15-17)

3. Prayer:

A) Individual:

Pray for the Holy Spirit to lead us and give us revelations daily so that we can rely on the Spirit in all things.

B) Families/schools/marketplace:

Declare that God's glorious cloud shall surround our families/schools/marketplaces, with walls of fires surrounding us and protecting us.

C) Church:

Declare that God's glorious cloud shall fill the church. There shall be more signs and wonders; the name of Jesus be lifted high and more people will be drawn to Him. Pray specifically for the IFRC which will be held on 26-29/8. Proclaim that God's Shekinah glory shall dwell in each family.

D) Daughter churches:

Pray for the LORD to anoint the daughter churches with the fire of prayer and evangelism. Cheras: Pray for the mid-autumn festival outreach on 14/9. GC611, Nongkhai: Pray for the ministry of follow-up, discipleship and pastoring.

E) Communities:

Declare a mighty outpouring of the Holy Spirit upon the local churches. The glorious cloud of God shall cover the entire area, releasing heavenly power and protection in our midst.

F) Nation:

Pray for the LORD to raise up more leaders like Moses in the political arena. They shall lead Malaysia into God's destiny through God's words and revelation.
