

Faithful Obedience to God

Abijah was the son of Solomon, grandson to David. He was recorded in the Bible as the only King who defeated Jeroboam of the Northern Kingdom in a war. And the defeat of Jeroboam was attributed to his being judged for the sin of idolatry. God judged him and his nation for the sin of the idolatry of Golden Calf. The victory of Abijah was a demonstration of the almighty power of God over the Golden Calf idolized by Jeroboam, and no credit was due to Abijah himself.



Abijah knew he was a descendant of King David, positioned to inherit a legacy of blessings, including God's promise for a perpetual descendant of King David on the throne, by which, Abijah would have known that God was the almighty God. Yet the critique given in 1 Kings 15:3 on Abijah was: ***“And he walked in all the sins of his father; which he had done before him; his heart was not loyal to the LORD his God, as was the heart of this father David.”*** So obviously, though he had much knowledge and military victories, these did not reflect him as a good king.

To Abijah, God seemed nothing more than a weapon to help him overcome an enemy. Though he declared God's power before Jeroboam, yet he allowed himself to sink into the sin of idolatry, being double-minded, far from serving God whole-heartedly.

God's yardstick for a good Christian is in respect of our hearts being like that of David, being like the elders in the Bread of Life family in loving God, with faithful obedience to our God. In short, whether we have committed our hearts totally to God, be faithfully obedient to God, whilst building an intimate relationship with God.

We can habitually said, “Dwell under His cover, serve God truthfully, be submissive to our elders, thus we can inherit their anointing, and live within the fullness of His grace.” All these are good and right, yet it must not be limited in the realm of concept and identity, but be translated practically into a whole-hearted love and trust upon God.

As at today we are still within our lunar New Year period. No matter where we were celebrating the New Year Festive season, brothers and sisters must continue to guard your hearts, remain connected to the Lord, be reminded that we have been separated as holy unto our God, thus requiring us to live out as a faithful testimony, no compromise, no giving ground to the enemy, nor allowing ourselves to be defiled by idols and ungodly traditions.

May you all remain under God's sacred cover throughout the Chinese New Year, enjoying divine protection in both your coming in and going out. At the same time, may all of you remain in the lifestyle of the New Man, being filled with the Holy Spirit every day. Wishing all of you a blessed New Year. ■



Close the Gap, Return to the Promise

1. The Blessing of Solomon

A) Building and Expansion by Solomon (2 Chr 8:1-6)

Solomon built God's Temple in 7 years and another 13 years to complete his palace. He cared not only for God and his own needs but also started to build cities for the Israelites to settle in. Solomon kept on expanding the Israel's boundary, building store cities to prepare for war and to fortify cities to withstand the enemies.

B) Solomon's Rule in Wisdom (2 Chr 8: 7-10)

It was by wisdom that Solomon managed and used the resources for the construction which required a great amount of labor. He conscripted the Gentiles in the land to serve as slave labor and made the Israelites his fighting men, commanders and chief officials.

C) Solomon's Service of Obedience (2 Chr 8: 12-16)

Solomon sacrificed burnt offerings to the Lord, according to the commands by Moses for the Sabbaths, the New Moons, the Festival of Unleavened Bread, the Festival of Weeks and the Festival of Tabernacles. He also kept the ordinance of his father David to appoint the divisions of the priests for their duties. Solomon was obedient toward his authority, took importance of the Lord's matters and even obeyed God's will in all building details of the temple and offerings.

D) Solomon's Continued Supply of Resources (2Chr 8: 17-18)

Hiram continued to supply Solomon according to his needs and became Solomon's continued resource of supply.

2. Solomon's Broken Gap (1 Ki 11:1-8, 9-11; 2 Chr 11:21a, 23)

In order to have diplomatic relation with Egypt, Solomon took Pharaoh's daughter as his wife. Moreover, he wanted to have alliance with them in politics and military affairs. Because of all these, Solomon began to compromise. Knowing that marrying Pharaoh's daughter was against the command of the Lord, Solomon even allowed her to worship idols in the palace which furthermore offended the Lord. Therefore, he built Millo outside of the city for his wives to worship idols but this has led to a greater entrance to idolatry. This broken gap is a leaven of sin for Solomon whereby it would keep expanding and became a cancer eventually no matter where it was placed and if it was not dealt with properly.

Solomon was in love with many foreign women and his heart was fascinated by them. This had led him astray from God to worship idols and even built high altars for this purpose. The Lord had forbidden Solomon to follow other gods but he did not keep the Lord's command. The land of Israel was divided because of this. Solomon's sin of lust had great implication on his second and third generation. His son, Rehoboam himself had a lot of concubines and he also took many wives for his sons.

3. Repentance As The Key Back to Promises

A) Humbly Confessing Our Own Sin

Admit that we are weak and avoid seeking excuses for the sins we have committed.

B) Praying to God Asking for Forgiveness

It is only through pleading for God's help that we are able break away from the bondage of sin.

C) Seeking the Lord Continuously

Even though we have overcome our previous weaknesses, we still have to depend on God to breakthrough every difficulty.

D) Turn Away From Evil Doings

We must stop the weak behaviors immediately when necessary to return to God. It can block the breach and lead us back to the promises. ■ [This sermon message was delivered on Jan 22, 2017. Edited by Sec. of editors.]
