One of the amazing visual aids God used to teach Israel about the Messiah is the seven Biblical Feasts built in to the Biblical Calendar. The Calendar was closely linked to the four seasons and the harvest cycles in Israel. The NT Bible identifies Him as the Lord Jesus Christ.

The Feasts were first mentioned in the Book of Lev. 23:2 *“Speak to the children of Israel, and say to them: ‘The feasts of the Lord, which you shall proclaim to be holy convocations, these are My feasts.’”* What we call today as Feast in the Hebrew Text is Moed meaning appointed season or time. The Feasts therefore are seasons or time appointed by God Himself, not by man! All these Feasts of the Lord are to be kept in all generations for Israel, as commanded in Lev. 23:21: *“And you shall proclaim on the same day that it is a holy convocation to you. You shall do no customary work on it. It shall be a statute forever in all your dwellings throughout your generations.”*

There are three related feasts in the spring season in the Hebrew month of Nisan, around March-April of the Western Calendar. As we enter the month of April, we will be entering the Passover Feast celebrated over seven days from Sundown of 11th to 18th of April 2017. In the Hebrew Calendar, it is the month of Nisan 14th – 21st covering a total of 3 related Feasts: Passover, Unleavened Bread & First Fruits. These three feasts point to the Death, Burial & Resurrection of the Messiah Jesus.

Feast of Passover

These are the feasts of the LORD, holy convocations which you shall proclaim at their appointed times. On the fourteenth day of the first month at twilight is the Lord's Passover. (Lev. 23:4-5)

In the first Passover in Egypt, the death of the lamb with its blood on the door frames of a house brought deliverance to the first born, but Jesus Christ the Paschal Lamb brought redemption to all sinners. When we come to Jesus as our Passover Sacrifice, we have peace with God (Rom. 5:1). By His blood, God entered our house (our life) and becomes our protector and provider. Therefore accepting Jesus as our Messiah, we become a Covenant people, we find peace with God. This is what the Passover symbolizes. It is the picture of the Prince of Peace, the Lord Jesus.

Feast of Unleavened Bread

These are the feasts of the Lord, holy convocations which you shall proclaim at their appointed times. On the fourteenth day of the first month at twilight is the Lord's Passover. And on the fifteenth day of the first month at twilight is the Feast of the Unleavened Bread to the Lord; seven days you must eat unleavened bread. (Lev. 23:4-6)

Christ Jesus represents the unleavened bread of God from Heaven, took on all the leaven of sin and was buried on Nisan 15. Whilst the Jewish people were removing physical leaven from their homes, Jesus removed the spiritual leaven of sin from our house ie. our life. He took our leaven of sin in His spirit, leaven of sorrows in His soul, the leaven of our sickness, disease and death in His own body. *“For God made Christ Jesus who knew no sin to be sin for us”* (2 Cor. 5:21), Jesus fulfilled the Feast by being buried with all the leavens of our sins, sorrows, sicknesses and pains.

Feast of First Fruits

Speak to the children of Israel, and say to them: When you come into the land which I give to you, and reap its harvest, then you shall bring a sheaf of the first fruits of your harvest to the priest. He shall wave the sheaf before the Lord, to be accepted on your behalf; on the day after the Sabbath the priest shall wave it. (Lev. 23:10-11)

It points to our resurrection with Jesus in our spirit as well as future physical resurrection. As the redeemed people of God, we are a picture of first fruits to the world. We do not have the supernatural, resurrected bodies, yet we are a foretaste of what is to come. As we begin to live the resurrected life Jesus in us, we become a new man with a new nature. Paul said, *“Therefore if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new.”* (2 Cor. 5:17). This new life bears the fruit of the Spirit: Love, Joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control. (Gal. 5:22-23). We have become the first fruits of God's creation.

Passover – Christian Reconciliation with God; Unleavened Bread – Christian Separation unto God & First Fruits – Christian consecration.

1. The King was Blessed (Esther 10: 1-2)

It is written at the beginning of the book of Esther that King Ahasuerus used 180 days to display the vast wealth of his kingdom. He also threw a banquet for officials from 127 provinces to establish good relations.

Now the king was greatly blessed - his ability and authority to govern had greatly increased. Everyone who lived in his territory had to pay tribute to him, whether it was people from the dry land or the islands - so long as they were from the 127 states from India to Cush. This is because he had a very godly queen, Esther and Mordecai, a prime minister who feared God.

2. Man with a Strong Inner Life

a) Different Life (Esther 10: 2, 3: 1)

Here, both Haman and Mordecai is being lifted, however the term 'lifted' refers to two different things. Haman's 'lifted' is to magnify - as in to advance and enlarge. Haman was lifted because he was magnified by man. He was given a glory and power that his life cannot support. On the other hand, Mordecai's 'lifted' referred to the inherent greatness of his inner life was made manifest. God took opportunity to reveal the greatness of his inner life to match his new position.

b) Different Ending (Esther 7: 10, 9: 12, 10: 3)

Mordecai's story was written in the history of Media and Persia. He was influential in the kingdom, and his status was second only to the king. His fame spread and grew rapidly in the provinces throughout the Persian Empire. He was also head of the Jews. Meanwhile Haman's fate was death. Not only did he die, even his 10 sons died.

If we are placed in a certain position, yet we do not possess the inner qualities and capacity, we might just set ourselves up for disaster. The higher position we hold, the more humble we need to be. We ought to follow God's will and let our inner life shine. Although Jesus is the Most High, He chose to humble Himself. So in the end, God lifted Him up high above all others. Haman followed the route of the fallen angel - Satan. He wasn't set at a high place, yet he chose to climb up high and desired to sit on God's place. As a result, he fell.

3. Becoming a Blessing to All (Esther 10: 3)

Mordecai was once a man without authority and status, he didn't even dare to reveal his identity. He was also an old Jewish prisoner. When his adopted daughter, Esther, became queen, he exposed the murder conspiracy against the king and saved the king's life with the help of Esther. Finally, he even saved the entire Jewish nation and became a blessing to all.

Although Mordecai was promoted to a high position, he continued to help the Jews and spoke peace to them. In the years of his life, the Jews no longer faced the danger of genocide. He became the son of peace in the city of Susa. Peace in Hebrew is shalom, it refers to blessings, health, safety, riches and harmonious relations. Mordecai's goal was to always help the people. And such a leader was definitely warmly welcomed and respected by the people. In fact, all the people of Persia loved him. ■ [This sermon message was delivered on March 19, 2017.
