

Return of the South Stream

During these two weeks, there are two special days and two amazing revelatory events. First and foremost was January 26th when we went to Hong Kong for meetings and celebration of Cimo's birthday at the same time. God actually used the date of this day to speak to us; that is, through Psalm 126,



"When the Lord brought back the captivity of Zion, we were like those who dream. Then our mouth was filled with laughter, and our tongue with singing. Then they said among the nations, "the Lord has done great things for them." The Lord has done great things for us, and we are glad. Bring back our captivity, O Lord, as the streams in the South. Those who sow in tears shall reap in joy. He who continually goes forth weeping, bearing seed for sowing, shall doubtless come again with rejoicing, bringing his sheaves with him."

"Bring back... as the streams in the South:" our Cimo's name also has the Chinese character "南" or South. In Israel, the streams flow towards the South and it is very hard to cause them to backflow. This is because the Southern land is on lower grounds, thus "the streams in the South were brought back," actually meant the return of the Jews, enabling the Israelites who were exiled for a long time to be brought back to their own land according to God's promises. What seemed impossible truly had happened: today, Israel is celebrating the rebirth of the nation for 70 years. The southern streams had truly flowed back means all that we had lost in the past shall be returned to us. It also includes what we sowed in tears in the past, now we shall reap in joy, bringing our sheaves back with us!

The second day was on January 31st, a very special day. While a blue moon by itself may not be that rare after all, it would be a truly unique when it coincides with a super moon and a total lunar eclipse, resulting in a rare astronomical phenomena. The last time when these three events coincided together was on March 31st in 1866!

On such a special occasion, a pagan religious celebration bumped into this "super blue blood moon." To some of the pagan religions, such a sign was not "auspicious" and thus, the temples would be closed for more than four hours, to the extent of covering the shrines in the main temple to forbid the believers from worshipping in the temples. Even the pagan priests would not be performing their duties as this was regarded as highly inauspicious.

However, as we had our morning devotion that day, we read Isaiah chapter 41, saying that all the molded images of idols are just wind and futile. That night, during the cell leader empowering meeting, we regarded this time, when the pagan religions had stopped their worship, as the time when the heavenly window is opened. We used a period of time to loudly pray and declare in unity, as it seemed like an unobstructed path had been opened to us without any hindrances.

We believed, just as the Scripture had said, that God will make us into new threshing sledges with sharp teeth. We believe there shall be a great harvest coming not long after, and all cell leaders had received new anointing on this night of the "super blue blood moon." ■

A King that Sought God and Worked Wholeheartedly

1 Restoration of the Temple (2 Chronicles 29: 1-5, 17, 21, 27-28, 30)

The first thing that Hezekiah did during the first month of the first year of his reign (he reigned for 29 years), he appointed the Levites to reopen the doors of the closed temple for repair and restoration. Hezekiah had done the right thing as soon as he became king. He brought about revival, therefore the entire spiritual status of the country changed.

2 Removing Idols and Breaking Strongholds (2 Chronicles 31: 1; 2 Kings 18: 4)

For centuries, finally a king did what was right in the sight of the Lord. He also followed all that his father David had done. He straightened things by clearing the wrong foundations of past beliefs as well as removed high places.

He destroyed the pillars and cut down the puppets, smashing the bronze snake made by Moses. This bronze snake was made about 800 years ago by Moses for the people to look up and get healed. Who knew that they would start worshipping this snake as God and burn incense to it.

Hezekiah was very brave and wanted to demolish the idols left by the ages. It was not an easy task for him to fight against people from both north and south.

For traditions that have lasted over the years, the strongholds are deep-rooted. Therefore courage is necessary for change to happen.

3 Restoring Service and Offerings (2 Chronicles 31: 2-3)

Hezekiah restored the service of rotation that was previously established within the temple. Some were responsible for offering sacrifices, some for praise and worship. Everyone took turns to serve so as to keep the fire within God's temple.

4 Offerings Firstfruits to God (2 Chronicles 31: 5-6)

Hezekiah encouraged the people to give tithes of all their produce and firstfruits of their grain to God. As a result, the people brought a great amount of everything and offered it to the temple of the Lord in Jerusalem, piling them in heaps.

5 People Were Blessed Abundantly (2 Chronicles 31: 8-10)

Due to revival, all the people were blessed by the Lord and a great amount was left over. When the leader does the right thing, and to turn to God, God will bless them and give them good harvest.

6 The More You Offer, The More You Receive (2 Chronicles 31: 15-19)

Every male that was 3 years old and above was entitled to consecrated gifts, this includes wives and children, and every serving family receives due portion. The entire nation lived in abundance. Hezekiah even commanded that a storehouse be prepared for storage in the house of the Lord.

It is very important to have a right king and a right leader as this brings revival to the nation. Not only did Hezekiah open the door of the temple and repaired the interior, he also restored all the spiritual property. He built people to serve and called the priests and Levites back. Even those who left God came back to observe the feasts, and did cleansing throughout the nation.

7 Prosperous in All Things (2 Chronicles 31: 20-21)

Hezekiah used seven months to do everything that was spiritually right. He did what was good and right and faithful before the Lord therefore revival came. Hezekiah sought God and worked wholeheartedly, and so God made him prosper. ■ [This sermon message was delivered on Jan 21, 2018. Edited by Sec. of editors.]

The Preparation for Having Open Cell Groups (5)

Allow for Departure, Know How to Let Go

There are some cell leaders who find it difficult to accept the leaving of cell members. The members of the open cell are mostly yet to commit to become your disciples. They are just like normal people, who are here to "eat your biscuits." If you have accompanied them, sang a song with them and did house cleansing for them, then Jesus will consider you as a good and faithful servant. You need not grieve over their leaving; for you shall receive the due award. If they truly want to leave, allow them to go. Of course, do not chase them away!

Promote Our Lives

If cell members leave, it has to do with the immaturity of the cell leaders. Cell leaders only need to improve upon their weaknesses and that is sufficient enough. All this experiences will cause the cell leaders to become broader and wider vessels, in preparation for an open cell. Do not grab hold of your cell members tightly and put all the energy on a few cell members. Some of the cell leaders take very good care of the cell members but exhaust all the energy and thus, dare not receive new cell members, resulting in only having a few cell members in many years.

Conclusion:

When we understand that cell group is like a reservoir of living water, then our shepherding will become much easier. Do not be overly disappointed over the loss of cell members, but to put importance on the new sheep coming in and greatly have hope! ■
