

Focused and Unwavering

Last Sunday, February 17th, was the 29th wedding anniversary of Rev Amos and me. On that day, Rev Amos gave me a surprise. I did not expect the co-workers and disciples to be the supporters behind the scenes. Many participated in this surprise and I was very touched! I hope that our marriage will be more and more blessed and be a model for all.



On the evening of February 16th, while having dinner with our children, suddenly I felt a little unease in my left eye. A shadow in the form of a mosquito appeared visually. As soon as I moved my eyeball around, the shadow in the mosquito form would follow in the same direction, and in the corner of my eye, there were some little irregular streams of light coming in, which were very disturbing to my vision. It was very uncomfortable and I was getting a little worried. After examination, I realized that this is just a sign of aging in the eye, the retina is somewhat slack, and the so-called "floater" occurs. In fact, the condition of my eye is not serious; the vision is still intact, and the degree of myopia has even been reduced. The only uncomfortable thing is that my vision is somewhat disturbed. After understanding the situation of my eye, I was relieved.

These few days, although the visual perception of the naked eye is affected, the vision of my spiritual eyes has been sharpened. God once again caused me to see His initial calling in us: to build the prayer tower, prayer room, and the prayer life of the intercessors. God even took a step further to say to us both: "The structure will be likened to the prayer tower in Herrnhut, in hexagonal shape, with spiral ladder connecting the heaven and earth along with 11 pillars." Rev Amos quickly helped me to draw this vision. This will be the first thing we do after our Sabbatical leave. Although the vision of my eyes is disturbed, there are revelations given to us.

As long as I stare straight ahead, this shadow likened to a form of a mosquito will remain in a corner and will not disturb my vision. However,



if I turn my eyeballs around and do not focus my gaze, the shadow will move in front of my eyes, distracting me. The same goes to our spiritual vision; we need to have a clearer focus based on the life vision God has given us. The enemy often uses our physical weaknesses and the surrounding environment to divert our goals and distract us.

However, when we rely on the grace of God and focus again on our vision, these disturbances will not be effective, but motivate us to rely more on God, and to advance towards our goals.

Dear brothers and sisters, in addition to evangelism, shepherding, as well as planting trees of life and churches in the nations, we must also pray for the economy and political stability of our nation, and sanctuary building of our church. When God expands our territory, He will also give us authority. May you also spend time to build intimate relationship with God and focus on the gifts and mission God has entrusted you, neither wavering to the left nor right. ■

The Lord is My Shepherd

A. God Provides Me with No Lack (Psa. 23:1)

The Psalmist David used "The Lord is My Shepherd" as the title for this Psalm. It clearly stated his relationship with God. He acknowledged that God is his Shepherd. For the Israelites, this was not an easy thing to do because religion defined the tribe. It was their ancestor's belief, a belief that was inherited by word of mouth. We called this faith the "secondhand faith".

How to transform secondhand faith into a true personal belief? The life of David enabled us to see how he personally experienced the reality of God. The relationship that he built with God was real and not just a religion. After acknowledging his relationship with God, he was no longer in any lack. But what did David lack in the past? From history, we can see that David was deprived of a good relationship with his father. When prophet Samuel came to the house of Jesse to anoint the new king, Jesse forgot about his youngest son, David. From here, we can see that David had been forgotten by his father. His relationship with his father was very distant.

B. God Shepherds and Cares for Me (Psa. 23:2-3)

The Lord is our shepherd; we are His sheep. A lot of people do not want to be sheep because we have the impression that sheep are dumb, short-sighted, unable to defend themselves and easily lose their lives in harsh environment. However, David was willing to humble himself and be God's sheep. We need to learn to be humble and be God's sheep by learning to listen and follow!

How does God shepherd His sheep?

1. Lying down: The sheep stretches out the four limbs and lies down, reflecting the sense of security.
2. Rest: We receive healing and rest.
3. Awakened: He turns back and brings those who have gone astray back
4. Guided: He leads the way of life

C. God Helps Me to Have No Fear in the Valley (Psa. 23:4)

God will guide us on the path of righteousness even though it may not be easy. Sometimes we face challenges, persecution and unto-ward incidents as we walk on the path of righteousness. The Psalmist referred to God as "The Lord", and then changed it to "Him" and finally "You", reflecting a gradual advancement and progression in relationship. Even though the path is challenging, this relationship will grow more and more intimate.

David went through low points in his life, for example before he ascended to the throne, he was chased after by Saul and later, pursued by Absalom who rebelled against him. During these tough days, God was still with him, and His rod and staff comforted him always.

D. God Causes My Cup to Overflow (Psa. 23:5)

God prepares a table before our enemies. This means we can completely forget the suffering and miseries that have come upon us. God wants to adjust our perspective. When we fix our eyes on God, we can then experience the blessings of the overflowing cup. This blessings and promises are unending.

E. Goodness and Mercy Shall Follow Me (Psa. 23:6)

David was steadfast in his belief that this Shepherd had given him an eternal promise, that goodness and love would follow him for the rest of his life. ■ [This sermon message was delivered on Feb 10, 2019. Edited by Sec. of editors.]
