Opening the Channel of "One New Man"

We had arranged for the "Warrior Bride Arising" conference based on our usual operating procedure. However, as we proceeded with the conference, God never failed to amaze us with His special planning. One of these days actually fell on May 9th which was the first anniversary of New Malaysia and coincided with the 71st Independence Day of Israel! God truly dwells in our midst!



This week during the morning devotions, we read Exodus 24-27, which recorded how God called Moses to go up to the mountain and then, up on Mount Sinai again for 40 days. On the seventh day, God took Moses into the clouds, and then revealed and promulgated the law to him. The first thing God talked to Moses about was the establishment of the tabernacle. The purpose of the construction of the tabernacle was that God wanted to dwell in the midst of His people in the wilderness.

The songs and worship training in the conference were actually related to the equipping of men to worship God, and were closely connected to the establishment of the tabernacle system in the morning devotions.

In the first special meeting, when Rev. Karen Davis played the keyboard, the prophetic team saw the glory of heaven falling like a waterfall on the altar of the prayer tabernacle. The prayer tabernacle was likened to a burning altar, with flames moving upwards, so the worship and the tabernacle seemed to echo one another. I believe this is the place and timing of the opening of heavenly window.

In chapter 25, God personally called on the people to offer gold, silver, bronze, purple, blue and scarlet thread to God willingly, asking them to pay a price for building the tabernacle. This is true worship, and when people offer in worship, God will in turn give to us. I am convinced that the "Warrior Bride Arising" conference is a new level of breakthrough in our worship to God!

When we read chapter 27 on Friday, the last two verses talked about preparing pure olive oil for the priests to light the lamps before God, and the lamps shall not go out all year round. It shows that everything is in the hands of God. He plans our lives and direction.

In the last lesson, Rev. Karen received a prompting to do a prophetic action to light the golden lampstand with me. I lit three branches while she lit another three, and finally we lit the middle branch together, representing the Gentile believers and the Messianic believers joining together to become one new man. I was very touched then and I believe it is a great blessing to do so.

Wow! This week, God allowed us know His heart and blessings for our nation. I believe we will see God's Will fulfilled more and more as we walk with Him! Our spiritual journey to Jerusalem has been smooth thus far. We believe that one day the physical passage shall be smooth as well! ■

Do Not Be Self-Righteous

1. The Repulsive Self-Righteousness Syndrome

A) I have Done Right by You! (Luke 18:9-11)

"You are God. I have done right by you! I have done what ought to be done. I do not owe you!" "Despise" means to look down on, to see the value of the works of others as nothing, to be supercilious. "To stand" means to stand in a prominent place to speak. Therefore, the Pharisees stood out during their prayer. In another version, it says, "to stand proudly praying loudly to himself, he actually wanted others to hear it. The content is regarding himself. The phrase that says, "Lord, I thank you", is actually an opening without any meaning.

B) I am Better! (Luke 18:11)

I am not like a lot of people outside. I am not like the tax collector in the sanctuary. I am a lot better than they are! He sees the weaknesses of others but not the plank in his own eyes.

C) I did Well! (Luke 18:12)

The Pharisees felt that they had done well enough, even more than what the law requires, as the law only requires fasting once a year on the Day of Atonement. The Pharisee felt that they had enough merits to boast on themselves.

2. Prescription Meeting God's Justification

A) Convicted of Sin and Seek Grace (Luke 18:13)

The tax collector standing far away in contrast to the Pharisees who stood up proudly. He knew he was not worthy of coming into the sanctuary, and knew he was not welcomed.

During the Roman era, the administration of tax was through bidding. The chief tax collector that received the most bid would need to give the tax as promised first. Then only would he go to the designated areas to collect the tax. For his vested interest, the tax collector would collect more and absorbed the excess. Tax was a tribute to Rome; it was not used for the development of the city. Tax was a way of the exploitation of the Jews to benefit the Romans.

This tax collector knew he had wronged many people, he knew his sins. However, he was so powerless against sin, so He was asking for mercy. He was like someone who owed a lot of money and ask for mercy from his debtor to lend him a little more money.

B) Be Humble and Received Grace (Luke 18:14)

"I tell you that this man, rather than the other, went home justified before God. For all those who exalt themselves will be humbled, and those who humble themselves will be exalted."

By God's standard, both these two men are not righteous, but there is one difference: one was convicted of his sin, one was not. One who knows his sin will know he needs grace. Those who are not aware of their sins do not feel a need for grace. God only chooses those who know their sins and need grace, irrespective of their life profession.

The self-righteous will not know that they are sinners. Not knowing their sins, they would therefore not think they need grace nor God; thus, God will not choose such a person. We are unable to know our sins. It is by God's grace for us to know our sins. Therefore, we need to humble ourselves to receive the grace of knowing sins. The spirit of supplication is also a gift of God, and we truly need the grace of God to not sin against Him. ■ [This sermon message was delivered on Apr 28, 2019. Edited by Sec. of editors.]
