Freedom & discipline Go Together With the “Mouth”

Most recently mother church 611 HK brought forward the 10th Core Value “Freedom follows Discipline”. This core value is very relevant with reference to our eating habit. We do enjoy absolute freedom on food, yet it must come with discipline, for we must select our food. Only as we eat the right food will we enjoy health, so that we can serve with the LORD and accomplish the vision of planting the trees of life for 52 years.



When we speak of health through food & drink, it is related to the concept put forward in his teaching by Prof. Luke Lin. We have known Prof. Lin for 14 years. Then he would conduct teaching at GA, and was our “conscience for health”. Each of his visit served as a strong reminder, motivated us to refresh our attention to proper eating, drinking & to overall health.

I believe man needs self discipline in food and drink, so that he may stay healthy. He emphatically stressed the Health Principle based on God’s Word, that is apart from taking the food that God has created – the herbs, fruits and grains brought forth by the earth, we must also add on them the spiritual health principle. These are what the Lord has prepared for man.

Some two months ago, owing to the pains I had in my backbone due to misalignment, I was forced to constantly remind myself of need for right posture in how I sit, stand, walk and sleep. As a result of misalignment through long term adoption of wrong posture, one will experience physical pains. Though the realignment process is painful, but I know this process is beneficial to me. Only as my backbone is restored to its correct alignment would the pain stop, thereby restoring my freedom to move. Health is the same, despite our freedom in food choices, it must be regulated by proper discipline. A person without good health will be deprived of his ability to serve.

The saying “sickness enters through the mouth, calamity hastens out of the mouth”. Edification is evident by anointed spoken words; when our speech is lined up with God’s will, it will bring forth blessings to others. What about what goes into our mouths? What we eat and drink, we often are casual about it, yet in the will of God, He is both mindful of what goes in and what comes out.

Very soon we will leave behind the Jewish year 5779 and enters into the year 5780. It is merely another 4 weeks before this “80” comes around! 80 in the Hebrew language is “Pey” meaning “mouth”. It is as if the Lord is preparing us to offer up our “mouth” to God before we step into this “mouth” season! Be it the prayer tower or healthy living, both are related to our “mouth”; our prayer life, healthy eating, speech of blessing, gospel evangelism, and teaching God’s word, are all related to the mouth! ■

Matthew 6:9-15**1. Our Human Problem**

Hurt, trauma, and pain are all part and parcel of the human life. As these hurts can create anger, hatred, and bitterness - it leads to the intention for revenge.

The hurt that we experience is usually from the past, therefore, should we choose to remain in our hurt, we will be imprisoned by it, and continue to live in the past, instead of moving forward.

2. The Solution

You can find a way out in Christ, because the center of the Christian faith is forgiveness, and Jesus who went on the cross has taken all our sins.

3. Why Must We Forgive?**A) The Command of Scripture (Col. 3:13)**

We are all believers of the Word of God. When God’s Word tells us to do this, we must do it.

B) The Example of Jesus (Luk. 23:34)

Because Jesus has become our role model, He is willing to forgive everyone when He went on the cross.

C) Otherwise We Cannot Come to God in Prayer (Mat. 6:12)

The Lord’s Prayer teaches us to forgive the sin of others as the Father forgives our sins, or we will lose the ability to pray before God.

D) Otherwise We Cannot Know God’s Forgiveness (Mat. 6:14, 15)

Jesus taught us to forgive others, otherwise we would not experience the forgiveness of the Father.

E) How Many Times Must I Forgive? (Mat. 18:21-22)

God wants us to forgive, not seven times, but seventy-seven times, meaning we are to forgive countless times, just as the Father has forgiven us many times.

4. What Happens When I Forgive? (Jam. 5:16)

When we don’t forgive others, our minds and hearts will be held by them, and we won’t be able to do what we want to do. In our minds, we can only keep replaying the scene of us being hurt. We will dwell in it and suffer in pain. Without forgiveness, both parties will be locked in jail, however with forgiveness, both parties will be released and healed, and see an improvement in the relationship.

5. Forgive and Forget?

Hurt prevents us from forgetting the past and forgiving each other, and our hearts and minds are just clouded with revenge and resentment. At this time, we need to fix our eyes upon Jesus on the cross. His suffering teaches us to humble ourselves because He has chosen to die for all our sins.

Forgiving it not forgetting. Forgiving is being tolerant of others in love.

6. How Do You Know When You Have Truly Forgiven?

If the wound is healed, no matter how we rub on it, there will be no pain. To know if we’ve truly forgiven someone, we need to see if we still feel pain when we meet the person who hurt us or when we think about the hurtful incident. If we still don’t feel at ease, it shows that we have not yet entered into real forgiveness. The solution is to go to the person who hurt us and ask for his forgiveness so that we can enter into real forgiveness. ■ [This sermon message was delivered on August 18, 2019. 

MG12 Good Shepherd's Tips

Never let go in shepherding (II)

How many cell leaders have ever kept a pet? Has the pet ever died? Is there anyone decided not to keep pet anymore after the death of his/her pet? If we have a dog and it got lost one day, we feel bad, or pet dog is dead so decided not to keep dog anymore. Some people said, "When my dog is dead, I am overwhelmed and I don't want to keep a dog so that I won't be hurt in future". Actually it is not that they don't love dog anymore, instead they are afraid of the pain of loss.

So keeping a pet has great relation with shepherding. Some cell leaders experienced hurts in the past and decided not to shepherd anymore. For example the cell members left one by one caused hurts or setback. But avoidance or fear shouldn't be the factors for our decision making. In every season of our life, if we make decision base on our fear and avoidance, the decision is not right. This will be a decision not base on faith and truth. When making a decision, we should ask ourselves, "Is it a decision of faith, or a decision of pessimistic and fear?" We should make decision by faith, not giving consideration to environment, for any decision base on fear or avoidance does not please God. How should we make decision according to God's will? Try all might, go for the maximum, to find the best result and condition. ■
